ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Now on this 17th day of December, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on November 14, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that American Federation of State, County & Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local No. 1774, an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that American Federation of State, County & Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local No 1774 should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Sioux County a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED All full-time and regular part-time non-professional employees of Sioux County including the following. janitors, attendants, laundry persons, cooks, custodians, equipment operators, sign-men, checkers, engineering technicians, maintenance men, mechanics, bridge repairman, and employees of the county conservation department with the exception of the secretary.

EXCLUDED Elected county officials, deputies of the elected county officials, commissioners, department directors, assistant county engineer, maintenance superintendent, foremen, administrators and their assistants, and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act
