AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING  
UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition of amendment of a bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621-4.6, the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of the East Union Community School District, initially determined in Case No. 607, and the certification of the East Union Education Association, are amended to read as follows:

**INCLUDED:** All professional full time and regular part time staff including, but not limited to, elementary, junior high, and senior high teachers, librarians, guidance counselor (on schedule), school nurse, resource room instructors, special education instructor and success coordinator.

**EXCLUDED:** Non-professional employees and administrators, principals, superintendent, secretaries, janitors, food service personnel, bus drivers, and secretarial aides and all those excluded by Iowa Code section 20.4.


