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NOTICE OF NONCERTIFICATION

Upon a petition duly filed in accordance with Iowa Code section 20.14 and PERB rule, a representative certification election was conducted herein under the direction and supervision of the Board. The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the valid ballots cast were not cast in favor of the affected bargaining unit's representation by the Sergeant Bluff-Luton Education Support Professional Association, and that no objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15 and PERB rule.

NOTICE IS THEREFORE GIVEN that no employee organization will be certified as the exclusive bargaining representative for the affected bargaining unit as a result of this proceeding and that the previously determined bargaining unit of employees of the Sergeant Bluff-Luton Community School District, described below, remains unrepresented for purposes of collective bargaining pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 20:

INCLUDED: All full time and regular part time PK-12 regular education/special education, and lunch associates; all full time and regular part time PK-12 paraprofessionals; all full time and regular part time PK-12 interpreters; all full time and regular part time PK-12 BASIC Care Providers; all full-time and regular part-time daycare workers; all full-time and regular part time PK-12 building custodians; all full time and regular part time PK-12 school nurses; all full time and regular part time PK-12 food service cooks; all full time and regular part time PK-12 bakers; all full time and regular part time PK-12 food service servers; all full time and regular part time PK-12 secretaries; all full-time and regular part time PK-12 bus drivers.

EXCLUDED: Technology coordinator, director of transportation, administrative secretary, director of operation and maintenance, hot lunch supervisor, curriculum director, business manager, school liaison officer(s), school social worker, daycare director, BASIC director, and all other full time and regular part time employees of the

public employer and any other person(s) excluded under
Iowa Code section 20.4.
