Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621-4.6(20), the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of the City of Cherokee, initially determined in PERB Case No. 853, and subsequently amended in PERB Case Nos. 6840, 6841, 6887 and 6912, and the certification of International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 234, are amended to provide:


INCLUDED: All employees in the following classifications: Deputy Clerk, Administrative Assistant, full-time Fire Department employees, full-time Street, Sanitation, Water and Cemetery employees, Street Foreman, Waste Water Foreman and Water Foreman.

EXCLUDED: All volunteer employees of the Fire Department and all other employees, including those excluded by Iowa Code section 20.4.

INCLUDED: All City of Cherokee employees in the following classifications: Deputy Clerk, Administrative Assistant, full-time Fire Department employees, full-time Street, Sanitation, Water and Cemetery employees.

EXCLUDED: All volunteer employees of the Fire Department and all other City employees, including those excluded by Iowa Code section 20.4.

AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION


