ORDER OF CERTIFICATION


NOW, on this 10th day of August, 1981, the Board being advised that an election was conducted pursuant to Order of the Board, and that a majority of the ballots were cast for International Union of Painters & Allied Trades, an employee organization; and the Board being further advised that said employee organization has complied with all requirements of the Act and the Rules and Regulations thereunder;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that International Union of Painters & Allied Trades, AFL-CIO, should be, and hereby is, designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Clinton County, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit:

INCLUDED: All Engineering and Secondary Road Employees. All maintenance employees, survey crew and secretaries.

EXCLUDED: Secretary to the Engineer (listed as confidential), Engineering Tech IV, District subforeman, Bridge foreman, shop foreman, maintenance foreman and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
