AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621-4.6(20), the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit initially determined in PERB Case No. 1603, and the certification of Public Professional and Maintenance Employees, Local 2003, is amended to provide:

INCLUDED: All employees in the Fort Madison street maintenance division, sewer division, paving marking and signs division, vehicular maintenance division, and solid waste division, including all machine operators, drivers, laborers, mechanics and maintenance personnel.

EXCLUDED: City engineer, operations supervisor, confidential secretary, sewer division supervisor, street maintenance division supervisor, paving marking and signs division supervisor, vehicular maintenance division supervisor, solid waste division supervisor, and all others excluded by Iowa Code section 20.4.

ORDER OF CERTIFICATION


NOW, on this 13th day of March 1980, the Board being advised that an election was conducted pursuant to Order of the Board, and that a majority of the ballots were cast for Painters & Allied Trades, Local 246, SECO Division, AFL-CIO an employee organization; and the Board being further advised that said employee organization has complied with all requirements of the Act and the rules and regulations thereunder;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Painters & Allied Trades, Local 246, SECO Division, AFL-CIO should be, and hereby is, designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of City of Fort Madison a public employer, in the following bargaining unit:

INCLUDED: All employees in the City of Fort Madison street maintenance division, sewer division, paving, marking and signs division, vehicular maintenance division, cemetery division, solid waste division, and parks, recreation and docks division, including all machine operators, drivers, laborers, mechanics and maintenance personnel.

EXCLUDED: City engineer, operations supervisor, confidential secretary, sewer division supervisor, street maintenance division supervisor, paving, marking and signs division supervisor, vehicular maintenance division supervisor, cemetery division supervisor, solid waste division supervisor, the director of parks, recreation and docks, the park superintendent, and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
