DONE by the Public Employment Relations Board this 12th day of March, 1982.







NOW, on this 27th day of October, 1978, the Board being advised that an election was conducted pursuant to Order of the Board, and that a majority of the ballots were cast for PAINTERS & ALLIED TRADES, LOCAL NO 246, an employee organization; and the Board being further advised that said employee organization has complied with all requirements of the Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that PAINTERS & ALLIED TRADES, LOCAL NO 246, should be, and hereby is, designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of HARDIN COUNTY, a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

- INCLUDED: All regular full-time patrolmen, mechanics, helpers, rodmen, dragline operators and inspectors employed by the Hardin County Secondary Road Department
- EXCLUDED: All office clerical employees, professional employees, supervisors, confidential employees, all persons excluded by Section 20 4, Code of Iowa (1977), and all other persons employed by Hardin County, Iowa, and its boards, commissions, agencies and departments
