Said Stipulation having been tentatively approved by the Board and posted in conformance with the Board's Rules and Regulations, and no objections having been filed thereto:


ORDER

INCLUDED: All regular full-time and regular part-time employees of the Secondary Road Department, including Operators I, II, and III, Mechanics, Signmen, Bridge and Culvert Foremen, Party Chief, Engineering Aides I and II, Laborer and Shop Clerk.

EXCLUDED: County Engineer, Engineering Assistant, First Assistant to the Engineer, Second Assistant to the Engineer, Maintenance Foreman, Office Manager, all other office and clerical employees, professional, supervisory, confidential employees, and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

Said stipulation having been tentatively approved by the Board and the and posted in conformance with the Board's Rules and Regulations, and no objections having been filed thereto:


ORDER
