MERGER OF UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for merger of bargaining units duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621—4.9, the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of the bargaining units for merger, which was tentatively approved by the Board. The stipulation merges the bargaining unit of employees that included the dispatchers and administrative assistants of the police department as well as full-time EMTs and full-time paramedics into the unit of the patrolmen and sergeants of the police department and fire captains of the fire department for the purposes of collective bargaining. A public notice of the Board’s proposed decision to merge the bargaining units in accordance with the parties’ stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB’s rules and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of the City of Centerville that was initially determined in Case No. 6543 and was amended by Case No. 102353, has merged into the bargaining unit of employees of the City of Centerville that was initially determined in Case Nos. 1277 and 4985 and was amended by merger in Case No. 102352, and amended its


certification in Case No. 8411. The successive bargaining unit of employees of the City of Centerville and the certification of AFSCME Iowa Council 61, is amended to read as follows:

INCLUDED: Patrolmen, Sergeants, Full-time Dispatchers and Administrative Assistants of the Police Department, and Assistant Fire Chief and Fire Captains of the Fire Department, and Full-time EMTs and Full-time Paramedics in the City of Centerville.

EXCLUDED: Chief, Assistant Chief, Part-time Dispatchers, Volunteer Firemen, Fire Chief, and all others excluded by Iowa Code section 20.4.

The successive bargaining unit of employees of the City of Centerville and the certification of AFSCME Iowa Council 61, as amended by Case No. 8411, is amended to read as follows:



AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION

the City of Centerville, described in PERB Case No. 1277, is hereby amended. The composition of the unit remains unchanged while the certified representative will hereafter be identified as AFSCME IOWA COUNCIL 61.



Upon a petition of amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621—4.6, the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. This stipulation amends the full-time EMTs and full-time paramedics into the bargaining unit. A public notice of the Board’s proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties’ stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB’s rules and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

A representative certification election was subsequently conducted among the employees proposed for addition to the unit (the full-time EMTs and full-time paramedics), and a majority of the valid votes were cast in favor of their representation by the certified employee organization. Thus, the Board finds that an order amending the bargaining unit should be entered.


