AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed under Section 13 of the Public Employment Relations Act [Act], Chapter 20, Code of Iowa (2001) and Rule 4.6 of the Public Employment Relations Board [Board or PERB], the parties filed with the Board a Stipulation of Bargaining Unit. Said Stipulation was tentatively approved by the Board and adds the position(s) of Maintenance Worker, Custodian, and Engineering Technicians I and II to the existing list of positions specifically included in the bargaining unit; a Public Notice of Proposed Decision of Amendment of Bargaining Unit was posted in conformance with PERB Rules; and no objections were filed. The representative certification election has been conducted, and a majority of the valid votes were cast in favor of the above classifications' representation by the certified employee organization, the Board finds that an order amending the bargaining unit should be entered.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit previously determined in Case No. 4602, and the certification of AFSCME/Iowa Council 61, is amended to read as follows:

INCLUDED: All regular full-time and regular part-time Maintenance Workers and Custodians employed by Warren County, and all regular full-time and regular part-time maintenance workers of the Warren County Secondary Road Department, including Bridge-Leadmen and Culvert Foreman, Shop Foreman, Paving Maintenance Foreman, Assistant Shop Foreman, Maintenance Worker, Equipment Operator I and II, Bridge/Culvert I and II, Motor Grade Operator I and II, Mechanic, Mudjack Foreman, Grading Foreman, Sign Foreman, Equipment Supply Mechanic, and Engineering Technician I and II.

EXCLUDED: County Engineer, Assistant to the County Engineer, Engineer's Assistant, Road Superintendent, Secretary, Land Surveyor, Engineering Technician III and Weed Commissioner.

INCLUDED: All regular full-time and regular part-time maintenance workers of the Warren County Secondary Road Department, including Bridge-Leadmen and Culvert Foreman, Shop Foreman, Paving Maintenance Foreman, Assistant Shop Foreman, Maintenance Worker, Equipment Operator I and II, Bridge/Culvert I and II, Motor Grader Operator I and II, Mechanic, Mudjack Foreman, Grading Foreman, Sign Foreman, Equipment Supply Mechanic.

EXCLUDED: County Engineer, Assistant to the County Engineer, Engineer's Assistant, Road Superintendent, Secretary, Land Surveyor, Engineering Technician I, II, and III and Weed Commissioner.
