ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2) was conducted under the supervision of the Board. The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying Ankeny Education Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election having been filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule 621-5.4, the Board finds that an order of recertification should be issued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Ankeny Education Association is hereby recertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit of employees of Ankeny Community School District:

INCLUDED: All certificated teacher personnel not prohibited by law and not hired to serve as teacher aides and/or associates. This would include, but not necessarily be limited to, classroom teachers (general subjects, art, music), physical education, special education (learning disabilities, remedial reading, speech clinician, psychologist), vocational teachers (agriculture and home economics), industrial arts teachers, librarians, guidance counselors, distributive education teachers trades and industry teachers, and registered nurses.

EXCLUDED: Superintendent, principals, vice-principals, directors of secondary and elementary education, director of non-instructional services, director of athletics, business manager, confidential secretaries assigned to work with any of the above positions, secretary to the board of education-Ankeny teacher aides or associates, and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
