ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) conducted a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2). The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying IAFF Local 301 as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule 621–15.4(20), and no postelection challenges were filed pursuant to PERB subrule 621—15.2(4). Therefore, the Board finds that an order of recertification should be issued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that IAFF Local 301 is hereby recertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit of employees of City of Burlington:

INCLUDED: All Captains, Lieutenants, and Firefighters of the Burlington Fire Department.

EXCLUDED: The Chief, Deputy Chiefs, Battalion Chiefs of the Burlington Fire Department and all others excluded by the Iowa Code section 20.4.




