ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) conducted a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2). The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying Carpenters Local 678 (Maintenance Personnel) as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule 621–15.4 and no postelection challenges were filed pursuant to PERB subrule 15.2(4). Therefore, the Board finds that an order of recertification should be issued.



AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION

EXCLUDED: All persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

A public notice of PERB's proposed decision to grant the requested amendment was issued and posted in accordance with PERB subrule 621-


4.8(2). No objections to the proposed decision were filed within the time specified in that notice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the certification of the Dubuque Building Trades Service Council as the exclusive bargaining representative for certain employees of the Dubuque Community School District is hereby amended. The composition of the unit remains unchanged while the certified representative will hereafter be identified as "Carpenters Local #678."


ORDER


