ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) conducted a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2). The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying State Police Officers Council as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule 621–15.4(20), and no postelection challenges were filed pursuant to PERB subrule 621—15.2(4). Therefore, the Board finds that an order of recertification should be issued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that State Police Officers Council is hereby recertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit of employees of State of Iowa:

INCLUDED: Conservation officers (05355)¹, and State Waters Officers (05426) of the Conservation Commission; Special Agents, Arson Investigators, Fire Prevention Specialists, Troopers, Capitol Security Guards I, Fire Inspectors in the Department of Public Safety, and Park Ranger I, II and III.

EXCLUDED: Conservation Enforcement Supervisors (05360), Conservation Enforcement Superintendent (05365), State Waters Supervisors (05430), and State Waters Superintendent (05435) of the Conservation Commission; Sergeants, Lieutenants, Captains, Capitol Security Guards II, Capitol Security Chief, Assistant Capitol Security Chief, and Enforcement Coordinators in the Department of Public Safety; and all other managerial, supervisory, confidential, part-time and all other employees of the State of Iowa; and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

DECISION ON REMAND

This case is before the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB) on remand with instructions from the Iowa Supreme Court pursuant to the Court's ruling in State of Iowa, Iowa Department of Personnel v. Iowa Public Employment Relations Board and State Police Officers Council, Supreme Court No. 113/95-397 (May 22, 1996).

BACKGROUND

This case was initiated by the filing of a petition for amendment of bargaining unit with PERB by the State Police Officers Council (SPOC) seeking to amend the job classifications of Park Ranger I, II and III (employed by DNR) into an existing certified bargaining unit represented by SPOC. The State resisted the requested amendment, and an evidentiary hearing was held before a PERB administrative law judge.

The ALJ issued a proposed decision and order on February 12, 1993. One of the issues before the ALJ concerned the State's claim that the park rangers were not eligible for inclusion in any bargaining unit because they are "supervisory" employees excluded

The record does not establish that rangers are "supervisors" within the meaning of section 20.4(2) based upon their authority to adjust the grievances of other public employees.

In summary, after considering the previously-existing record as supplemented by the new evidence regarding the park attendants' inclusion into an AFSCME-represented bargaining unit, our essential conclusions concerning the alleged supervisory status of the park rangers remain unchanged.

The park attendants' new unit status has not in any way affected the park ranger/DNR aide relationship or our conclusions concerning alleged supervisory status based thereon. Nor does the park attendants' inclusion into an AFSCME-represented unit alter our prior conclusion that the rangers are not true supervisors on the basis of their authority concerning the attendants. The park rangers are lead persons as to the park attendants, rather than true supervisors, regardless of the attendants' bargaining unit status.


Consequently, we conclude that the park rangers are bargaining-eligible nonsupervisory employees who are appropriately included within the SPOC-represented unit, and therefore enter the following

ORDER

The bargaining unit of employees of the State of Iowa represented by the State Police Officers Council is hereby amended to include the classifications of Park Ranger I, II and III.

DECISION AND ORDER

The above-entitled matter came on for hearing before the Public Employment Relations Board on August 9, 1976, pursuant to prior order of the Board. Gene A. Vernon appeared on behalf of the State of Iowa; Alvin W. Logan and W. Patrick White appeared on behalf of the Staff Employees Collective Organization (SECO); Habbo Fokkena appeared on behalf of the Iowa State Troopers Association and Iowa Fish and Game Officers Association, Inc.; R. J. Smith appeared on behalf of the Iowa Department of Public Safety Special Agents Association; David Williams and Raymond Conley appeared on behalf of the State of Iowa Employees Association, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (SIEA/AFSCME); and Charles E. Gribble appeared on behalf of the Iowa Land and Waters Conservation Officer Association.

The parties waived the formal presentation of any testimony or evidence in this matter and stipulated to the bargaining unit as set forth in the amendments to the petition in Case No. 294 (Exhibits 1 and 2).

The Board, having reviewed the stipulation of the parties and finding no objection thereto, finds that the following bargain-

ing units are appropriate for purposes of collective bargaining within the meaning of Section 13(2) of the Public Employment Relations Act:

1. Public Safety Unit:

Included: Conservation officers (05355)^{3/}, and State Waters Officers (05426) of the Conservation Commission; Special Agents, Arson Investigators, Fire Prevention Specialists, Troopers, Capitol Security Guards I, and Fire Inspectors in the Department of Public Safety;

Excluded: Conservation Enforcement Supervisors (05360), Conservation Enforcement Superintendent (05365), State Waters Supervisors (05430), and State Waters Superintendent (05435) of the Conservation Commission; Sergeants, Lieutenants, Captains, Capitol Security Guards II, Capitol Security Chief, Assistant Capitol Security Chief, and Enforcement Coordinators in the Department of Public Safety; and all other managerial, supervisory, confidential, part-time and all other employees of the State of Iowa; and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.




Included: All Security and related employees of the State of Iowa as set forth in Appendix A hereto.
