ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) conducted a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2). The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying Sioux City Police Officers Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule 621-15.4 and no postelection challenges were filed pursuant to PERB subrule 15.2(4). Therefore, the Board finds that an order of recertification should be issued.



AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the certification of Sioux City Policemen's Association as the exclusive bargaining representative for certain employees of Sioux City, originally described in PERB Case No. 537 is hereby amended. The composition of the unit remains unchanged while the certified

representative will hereafter be identified as **Sioux City Police Officers Association.**

INCLUDED: All regular sworn members of the Sioux City Police Department including the position classifications of Police Officer, Police Sergeant, and Police Lieutenants.

EXCLUDED: The following position classifications are excluded from the unit: Chief of Police, Assistant Chief of Police, and Police Captain.

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
