AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION



The composition of the unit remains unchanged while the certified representative

will hereafter be identified as:

DECISION ON APPEAL

This matter is before us on appeal of a proposed decision and order issued by an administrative law judge (ALJ) of the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) concerning a petition for amendment of bargaining unit filed by Communications Workers of America, Local 7175 pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB subrule 621-4.6(20). In its petition, CWA seeks to amend the following bargaining unit it represents, which was previously determined in PERB Case No. 836:

INCLUDED: All clerks, typists, assistants, aides, drivers, librarians and custodians.

EXCLUDED: Directors, department heads, administrative secretaries, and those excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

CWA seeks to amend the unit by removing the classifications of clerks, typists, drivers and custodians from the list of classifications included in the unit, since those

formulating" prong of the conjunctive test, due to their roles in independently developing programs, there is insufficient evidence that their duties involve any significant potential conflict of interest between the City and fellow workers. Their duties do not have a significant potential impact on employment matters indicative of a conflict of interest as were present in such cases as City of Manchester, 06 PERB 2006 (where employees were solely formulating departmental budgets, potentially affecting monies available for employee wages and benefits) or West Harrison Education Association, 04 PERB 2004, (where an employee's development of curriculum could affect staffing levels).

We have considered and rejected other arguments advanced by the City on appeal. We conclude that the four classifications at issue are not managers within the statutory exclusion and that the bargaining unit should be amended to include them, and to reflect the stipulations reached by the parties.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of the City of Waterloo most recently described in Case No.836, and the certification of the Communications Workers of America, Local 7175, is amended to provide:

INCLUDED: All Assistants, Aides, Librarians, Network & Information Literacy Administrator, Diversity Services Coordinator, Volunteer Coordinator/ Marketing Manager, and Teen Services Librarian.

EXCLUDED: Director, Department Heads, Administrative Secretaries, Reference & Technical Systems Administrator, and those excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

ORDER OF CERTIFICATION


