ORDER OF CERTIFICATION


Now on this 30th day of June, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on May 28, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that the Danville Education Association an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that the DANVILLE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of the Danville Community School District a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED All professional employees, including classroom teachers, remedial reading teachers, librarians, guidance counselors, and all special teachers (art, music, physical education and learning disabilities)

EXCLUDED Superintendent, principals, teacher aides, secretaries, janitors, cooks, bus drivers, and all others excluded by Section 4 of the Act
