
ORDER

Man; and Other personnel not excluded by the  
Act.

EXCLUDED: The following full and part-time employees:  
Utility Manager; Distribution Superintendent;  
Power Plant Superintendent; Administrative  
Clerk; Confidential Secretary; and all other  
personnel excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City of Maquoketa Employees Association should be, and hereby is, designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of the City of Maquoketa a public employer, in the following bargaining unit:

INCLUDED: All City employees in the following departments: full and part time - clerical and non-professional in City Hall; Water Dept.; Waste Water Dept.; Public Works Dept.; Power Plant and Distribution; Janitorial; Inspector; Mechanic Operator; Operator; Lineman/foreman; Linemen; Meter Personnel; Labor; Equipment Operator; and other personnel that are not in Public Safety Unit and not excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

EXCLUDED: City Manager; C.D. Director; Water Supt.; Waste Water Supt.; Public Works Supt.; Power Plant Supt.; Electric Dist. Supt.; Confidential Employees and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.
