ORDER OF RECERTIFICATION

Following the filing of an order directing an election, the Public Employment Relations Board (Board) conducted a retention and recertification election pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(2). The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the employees in the bargaining unit voted in favor of retaining and recertifying Independence Educational Support Personnel as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule 621–5.4, and no postelection challenges were filed pursuant to PERB subrule 621–5.2(1)(b)(2) and PERB rule 621–5.6(8). Therefore, the Board finds that an order of recertification should be issued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Independence Educational Support Personnel is hereby recertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit of employees of Independence Community School District:

INCLUDED: Secretaries, associates, food service employees and custodians.

EXCLUDED: All administrative, supervisory and confidential personnel as well as certified staff and all other classified staff not listed above.

AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION

Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621-4.6(20), the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to combine two bargaining units represented by the Certified Employee Organization in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of the Independence Community School District initially determined in PERB Case No. 8192 is amended to include those employees of the District in the bargaining unit initially determined in PERB Case No. 8201. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the certification of Independence Educational Support Personnel is amended to reflect its status as the certified exclusive bargaining representative of this single combined unit, which is described as:

INCLUDED: Secretaries, associates, food service employees and custodians.

EXCLUDED: All administrative, supervisory and confidential personnel as well as certified staff and all other classified staff not listed above.





Said stipulation having been tentatively approved by the Board and the Board having no objections;




