ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Now on this 9th day of September, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on August 28, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that Martensdale-St Marys Education Association an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that Martensdale-St Marys Education Association should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Martensdale-St Marys Community School District a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED This unit shall be comprised of all professional personnel in the Martensdale-St Marys Community School District who are full or regular part-time employees, including but not limited to classroom teachers, academic, vocational, remedial, special education, physical education, music, drama, librarian, guidance counselor, and nurse

EXCLUDED Superintendent, principals, nonprofessionals and all others excluded under Section 4 of the Act
