

AMENDMENT OF BARGAINING UNIT AND CERTIFICATION



- EXCLUDED: Superintendent, principals, school nurses, bus drivers, custodians, cooks, and all other employees excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that Nashua Schools Education Association, should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of Nashua Community School District a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED All Classroom teachers, librarians, and guidance counselors.

EXCLUDED Superintendent, Principal, all auxiliary personnel (secretaries, cooks, janitors, teachers aides, bus drivers and nurse), and all other personnel strictly prohibited by Section 4 of the Act
