ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

Now on this 4th day of August, 1975, the Board being advised that an election was conducted on June 26, 1975, pursuant to order of the Public Employment Relations Board and that NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL WORKERS UNION an employee organization, received an affirmative vote of a majority of employees in the bargaining unit, and the Board having further found that the aforesaid employee organization has fully complied with all regulations of the Public Employment Relations Act and the rules and regulations thereunder,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE BOARD that NATIONAL INDUSTRIAL WORKERS UNION should be and hereby is designated and certified by this Board to be the exclusive bargaining representative for the employees of TAMA COUNTY a public employer, in the following bargaining unit

INCLUDED All truck drivers, operators, patrol operators, mechanics, laborers, inspectors, rodmen and working foremen.

EXCLUDED The engineer, assistant to the engineer, office clerical, confidential, and supervisory employees, and all other persons excluded under Section 4 of the Act
