Upon a petition for amendment of bargaining unit duly filed pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.13 and PERB rule 621-4.6(20), the parties filed with the Board a stipulation of bargaining unit as amended, which was tentatively approved by the Board. A public notice of the Board's proposed decision to amend the bargaining unit in accordance with the parties' stipulation was posted in conformance with PERB's rules, and no objections to the proposed decision were filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bargaining unit of employees of Black Hawk County determined in PERB Case No. 48, and the certification amended in PERB Case No. 2033 to Public, Professional and Maintenance Employee Local Union 2003, IBPAT, is amended to read as follows:

INCLUDED: All employees of Black Hawk County with job classifications of laundry worker, kitchen aide, cook, assistant cook, matron, janitor I, janitor II, security guard, and parking lot attendant.

EXCLUDED: Professional employees, supervisors, and other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act, and all other county employees.
