INCLUDED All employees of the Taylor County Secondary Roads Department including Engineering Technicians I, II & III, Engineering Aids, Shop Superintendents, Mechanics, Maintenance Superintendents, Maintenance Operators I, II & III, and Maintenance Laborers I & II.

EXCLUDED County Engineer, Assistant to the County Engineer, General Superintendent, Office Manager and Secretary and all those excluded by Section 4 of the Act
