Upon a petition duly filed in accordance with Iowa Code section 20.14 and PERB rule, a representative certification election was conducted herein under the direction and supervision of the Board. The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the valid ballots were cast in favor of the affected bargaining unit's representation by Professional Educators of Lynnville-Sully, that no objections to the election were filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15 and PERB rule, and that the employee organization has complied with the relevant requirements of Iowa Code section 20.25.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Professional Educators of Lynnville-Sully is hereby designated and certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the following bargaining unit of employees of the Lynnville-Sully Community School District:

INCLUDED: All professional certificated personnel of the Lynnville-Sully School District including classroom teachers, remedial reading teachers, special education teachers, physical education instructors, vocal and instrumental music instructors, art teachers, vocational agriculture instructors, drivers education instructors, counselors, librarians, and non-certificated school nurse.

EXCLUDED: Administrators and all non-professional employees of the Lynnville-Sully School District: secretaries, custodians, bus drivers and bus maintenance, cooks, and all other persons excluded by Section 4 of the Act.

Following the filing of a valid representative decertification petition pursuant to Iowa Code section 20.15(6) and PERB rule, a decertification election was conducted herein under the supervision of the Board. The Board, having subsequently reviewed the file and being fully advised in the premises, finds that a majority of the valid votes were cast in favor of the decertification of the Lynnville-Sully Education Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of the bargaining unit described below.

No objections to the election having been filed as provided for in Iowa Code section 20.15(4) and PERB rule, the Board finds that an order of decertification should be issued.

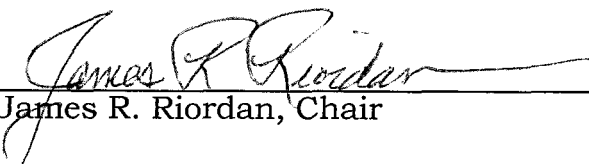
