## All Employers: Contracts with Expiration date of June 30, 2019 AEAs, K/12, Community Colleges with Expiration date of June 30-August 31, 2019

PERB will conduct a retention and recertification election for this bargaining unit by telephonic and webbased ballot. The schedule for this telephonic/web-based election is as follows:

September 4, 2018	Last day for the Public Employer to submit the initial voter list to determine the fees by e-mail in Excel format.
September 17, 2018	Last day for the Employee Organization to pay the election fee according to the fee schedule.
September 19, 2018	Direction/Notice of Election filed. Voter must be employed on this date in the bargaining unit to be an eligible voter except if the parties agree on a different eligibility date pursuant to PERB Rule $5.2(1)(b)$ .
September 26, 2018	Last day for Employer to update the voter eligibility list, if necessary, by e-mail in Excel format. If not updated, the initial list becomes the voter eligibility list.  Additionally, the employer shall promptly notify the employee organization of any employee in the bargaining unit that leaves employment after the date of the direction of election through the last date of the election.
October 8, 2018	Last day for Employee Organizations to propose additions to or deletions from the voter eligibility list and for the parties to mutually agree on any change in the voter eligibility list. Last day for a party to challenge a person's status as an eligible voter.
October 15, 2018 8:00 a.m.	Voters may begin to cast their ballot by calling the toll-free number or logging on to the voting website to cast their ballot. The number and website will be provided in the Notice of Election
October 29, 2018 9:00 a.m.	Voters must cast their ballot by phone or online prior to this time and date in order for the ballot to be counted. A PERB election agent will review the tally of the results at PERB's office.
November 8, 2018	Objections to the election or postelection challenges filed pursuant to PERB rule $5.2(1)(b)(1)$ are due. (If the tally of ballots was filed after October 29, 2018, then the objections or postelection challenges are due 10 days from the date the tally was filed).
